



Finding the MAC Address on Your Device

1. iOS devices: iPad, iPhone or iPod Touch
2. Mac Air, Pro, Mini and iMac
3. Android
4. Windows Workstation

To locate the Media Access Control (MAC) Address of your iPad, iPhone or iPod Touch, follow these steps:

1. Tap Settings.
2. Select General.
3. Select About.
4. The Mac address is listed as Wi-Fi Address.

To locate the MAC Address of your Mac Air, Pro, Mini and iMac, follow these steps:

1. Go to **System Preferences**
2. Select **Network**
3. Select **Ethernet** then click **Advanced**
4. Click on **Hardware** tab to display MAC Address

To locate the MAC Address of your Android, follow these steps:

1. Under your Applications, select **Settings**
2. At the very bottom of the list, choose "**About Device** (Android Phones may say **About Phone**)
3. Choose **Hardware Information** (or **Status** menu)
4. Your MAC address will be listed under Wi-Fi MAC Address.

To locate the MAC Address of your Windows computer, follow these steps:

1. At the command prompt, type **ipconfig /all**, and then press Enter.
2. Look for the following under the "Ethernet adapter Local Area Connection:" heading:
Physical Address. : **xx-xx-xx-xx-xx-xx**
